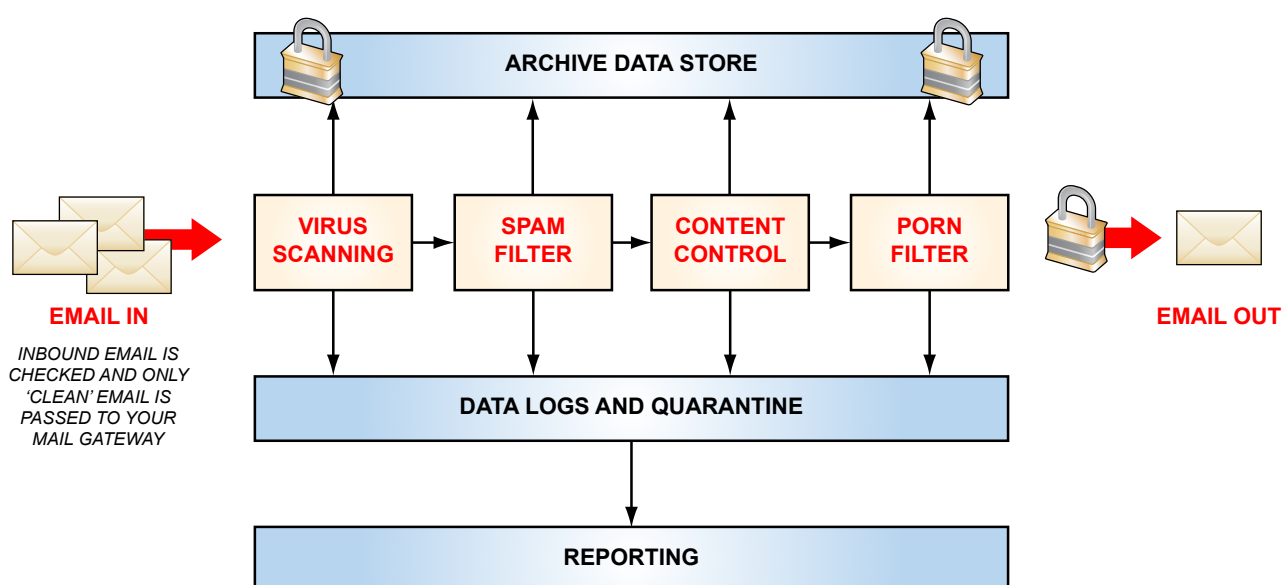

For users who are part of a Federation (such as the UK Access Management Federation), access to the web-based management interface can be controlled via Shibboleth® technology so that familiar usernames and passwords can be used.
